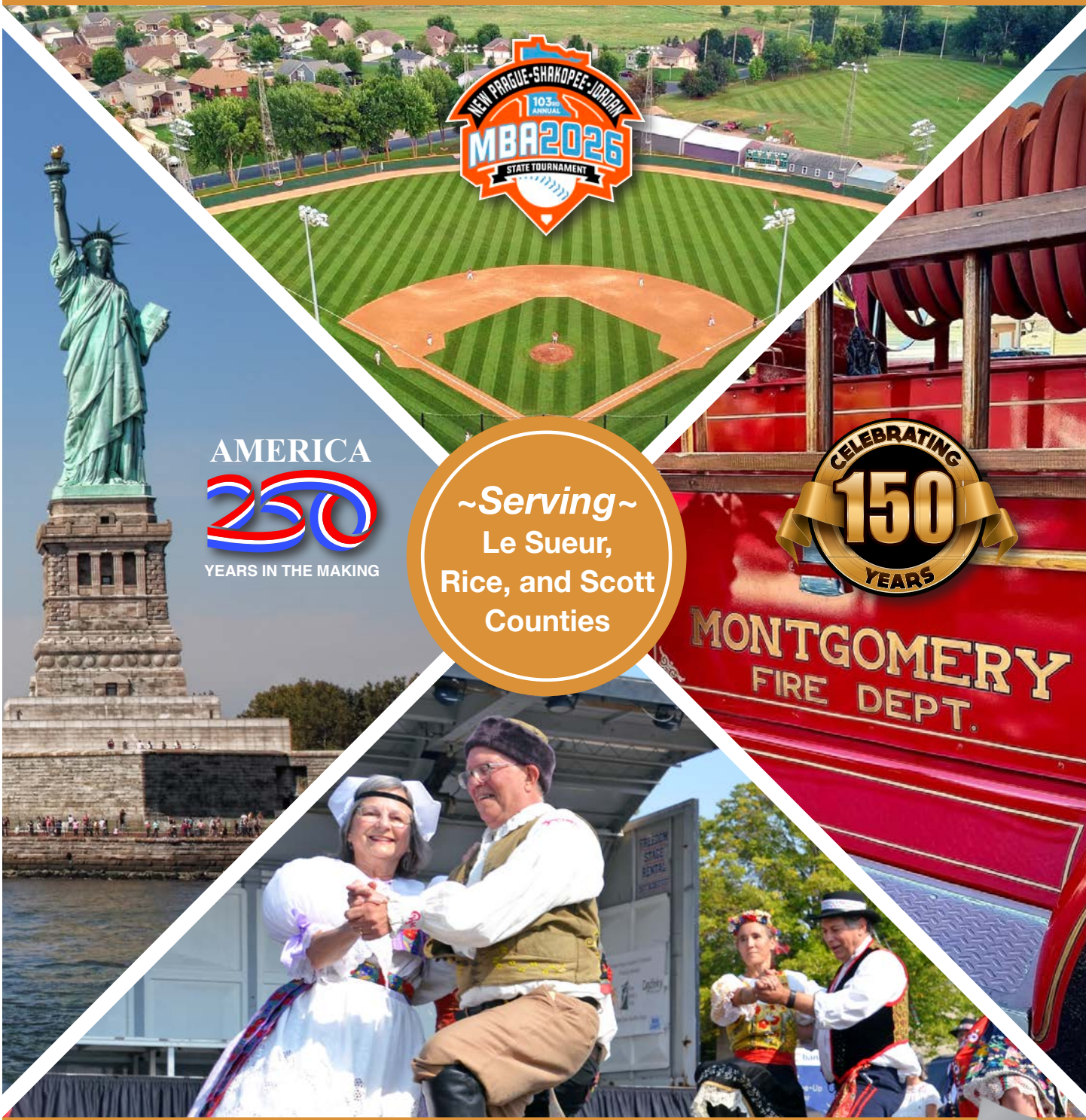

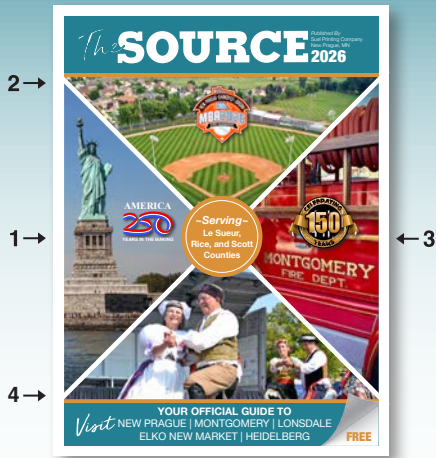

250th Anniversary AMERICA

The 250th anniversary of the USA (Semiquicentennial) will be celebrated on July 4th, 2026, marking 250 years since the adoption of the Declaration of Independence. Led by the America250 initiative, the celebration runs through 2026, featuring nationwide events, historical reflections, and community engagements to honor the nation's past and future.

In honor of our nation's 250th Anniversary New Prague will be celebrating America's freedom and independence with their largest Fireworks Spectacular ever on Friday, July 3, 2026 East of the New Prague Middle School, 10:10 p.m. You won't want to miss this great summer tradition!

Lonsdale will also be celebrating the USA's Semiquicentennial as well as honoring Lonsdale's history, heritage and founding with the Founders Festival on July 3, 2026, 3 p.m. - midnight. The celebration will also include a Fireworks Show.

The Declaration of Independence

The Declaration of Independence is a formal document that served as the signatory colonies' statement that they were now "free and independent States." It is a vital document in American history.

On July 1, 1776, delegates from the original 13 colonies, making up the Second Continental Congress, met in Philadelphia to vote on Richard Henry Lee's motion for independence. After some deliberation, ultimately 12 of the 13 delegates voted in favor. In recognition of those 12 delegates, here are 12 facts regarding the Declaration of Independence.

1776, two days after freedom from Britain was approved. However, most delegates signed the document on August 2, 1776, while others signed on a later date. John Dickinson and Robert R. Livingston never signed the Declaration of Independence.

New Prague helping host 2026 state baseball tournament

New Prague will be among four area communities that will host the Minnesota Baseball Association's 2026 State Baseball Tournament.

Nick Schoenecker, with Chuck Nickolay, is chairing the New Prague portion of the tournament. He said it will be held Aug. 21-23, Aug. 28-30, and Sept. 4-Sept. 7 with the championship game to be played on Labor Day. Other communities hosting the tournament are Shakopee, Jordan and Chaska. "Each site will host 23 games," Schoenecker said, although Chaska will be hosing eight games.

"It will be very similar to when New Prague hosted the state tournament in 2018," Schoenecker said. He noted one change is there were only two classes, B and C, in 2018 and in 2026 a Class A has been added bringing it up to three. Schoenecker described Class A as being teams that are located in metropolitan areas with former college players. Class C is from smaller towns with more local players and Class B is in-between the two, said Schoenecker. There will be 32 teams playing in the Class C division and 16 teams in both the Class A and B divisions, he said.

"Shakopee approached us about hosting the tournament," Schoenecker said, adding the communities put in a bid with the Minnesota Baseball Association and won.

"This has been a few years in the making," said Schoenecker. At New Prague's Memorial Park Baseball Stadium, 400 Lexington Ave S, a deck was added along the first baseline and a bullpen was added on the visitor's side of the baseball park, Schoenecker said. Through the improvement the New Prague Baseball Association has been working with New Prague city staff, which Schoenecker said has been a good experience. The improvements have cost between \$25-\$30,000, said Schoenecker.

"Back in 2018 there were 18,000 people who attended," Schoe-

necker said. "This time we're expecting an attendance of 25,000. Each year it's gown."

A goal for New Prague is to get the New Prague Orioles and Veseli to win enough games to qualify for Class C, region 17 in the tournament. It is also hoped Class B teams of Webster, Lonsdale, Union Hill and Montgomery will qualify.

Montgomery, MN Fire Department's History

The Montgomery Fire Department has a rich history dating back to its establishment in 1876. It has been a vital part of the community's safety and emergency response efforts.

A strong, enduring fire prevention program was initiated by Fire Chief C.E. Ingram in 1932, which significantly reduced fire losses in the city.

The department has evolved over the years, with its current volunteer structure and commitment to providing essential fire and rescue services. The department's dedication to protecting and serving the community is evident in its ongoing operations and the support it receives from its members and the public.



The department serves both the city of Montgomery and the surrounding townships and is celebrating its 150th anniversary June 19 & 20, 2026, marking a century and a half of service to the community.

The celebration will begin with a golf tournament at the Montgomery National Golf Club on June 19 and continue on June 20 with live music entertainment, food vendors, and bounce houses for the kids in Memorial Park and other events downtown such as a classic Car Roll-In with musical entertainment, water fights and a parade. There will also be a raffle with great prizes and the celebration will be topped off with fireworks.

Declaration of Independence... from 4

2. John Dunlap was the official printer of Congress at the time. He worked all night and into the morning of July 5 to produce the large, single-sided sheet, known as a broadside. About 200 copies of Dunlap's broadside were made.

3. The University of Virginia owns two copies of a rare early printing of the Declaration. It is on display in the Albert and Shirley Small Special Collections Library. It is believed the copy once belonged to George Washington.

4. Benjamin Franklin, George Read, Roger Sherman, Robert Morris, George Clymer, and James Wilson signed both the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution.

5. The Declaration of Independence and the Constitution were hidden at Fort Knox during World War II, two weeks after Pearl Harbor was attacked.

6. Despite what the movie "National Treasure" will have one believe, the message on the back of the document is visible and reads "Original Declaration of Independence dated 4th July 1776."

7. Richard Stockton, a lawyer from New Jersey, was a signer of the Declaration who later recanted his support of the American revolution. He subsequently swore his allegiance to King George III after being captured by the British.

8. In 1989, an original Dunlap Broadside was found hidden behind a picture a Philadelphia man bought at a flea market for \$4. It later sold for \$8.1 million. Ultimately, 26 copies of the original prints have been found.

9. The United States celebrates Independence Day on July 4th, even though independence was accepted on July 2nd.

10. Early on, not everyone in America was supportive of the Declaration of Independence. Partisan politics led to discord. Federalist John Adams was feuding with Republicans and Thomas Jefferson. The anniversary date of the signing was not widely celebrated until the Federalists were no longer involved in politics.

11. The one-year anniversary of Independence Day and the celebration of the adoption of the Declaration of Independence slipped the minds of Congress in 1777. When they remembered it was July 3rd, they planned a last-minute celebration on July 4th, and each year thereafter.

12. John Trumbull's painting "Declaration of Independence," which was made into a lithograph replica by Ralph Trembly, hangs in the Rotunda of the U.S. Capitol. It is a fictional depiction of the five-man drafting committee presenting their draft to Congress, and not the signing. The painting shows 42 of the 56 signees, since Trumbull couldn't get likenesses of all involved. The men featured in the painting were never all in the room at the same time during the Declaration's debate and signing.

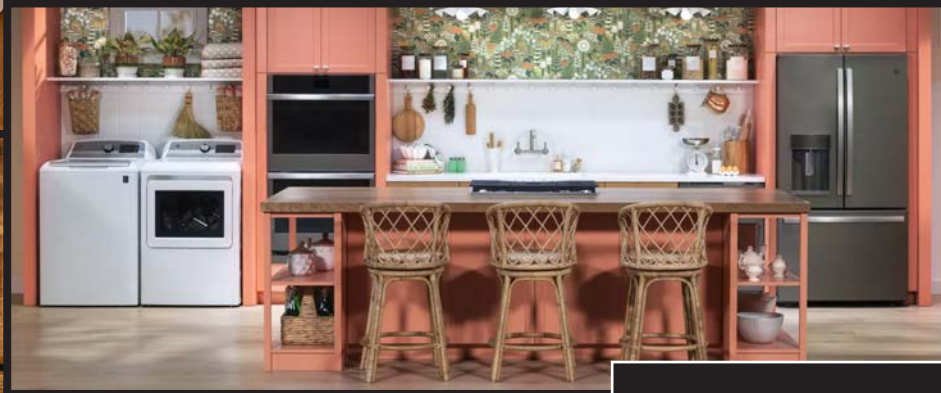
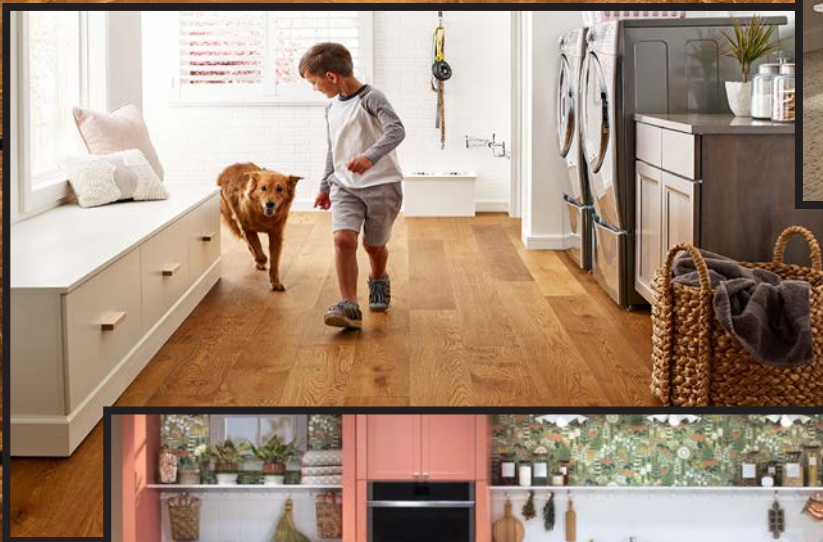
