**Naming of Proposed Public Street
Extending Westerly from the intersection of
Luella Street and Beachell Street
(Ward 38 - Scarborough Centre)**

(City Council on July 22, 23 and 24, 2003, adopted this Clause, without amendment.)

The Scarborough Community Council recommends the adoption of the following report (June 27, 2003) from the City Surveyor, Works and Emergency Services:

Purpose:

This report recommends that the proposed public street extending westerly from the intersection of Luella Street and Beachell Street, be named "Conn Smythe Drive".

Financial Implications and Impact Statement:

There are no financial implications resulting from the adoption of this report.

Recommendations:

It is recommended that:

- (1) the proposed public street extending westerly from the intersection of Luella Street and Beachell Street, as shown on Attachment No. 1, be named "Conn Smythe Drive" ; and
- (2) the appropriate City Officials be authorized and directed to take the necessary action to give effect thereto.

Background:

A request has been made by Cathie Gilbert of the Conservatory Group (80 Tiverton Court, Suite 300, Markham, ON L3R 0G4) on behalf of Viewmark Homes, to name the proposed public street extending westerly from the intersection of Luella Street and Beachell Street. The street is proposed to be extended southerly to Eglinton Avenue East in the future. The naming is required to facilitate the assignment of municipal addresses to the proposed residential units fronting the street.

Richard Schofield of the Scarborough Preservation Panel has suggested that the street be named after the hockey legend, Conn Smythe. The Smythe family lived in this neighbourhood and as a youth Conn attended the Scarborough Village School. Conn Smythe bought the Toronto St. Pat's in 1927, renamed them the Maple Leafs and built Maple Leaf Gardens four years later.

Comments:

The proposed name "Conn Smythe" has been circulated for comment and has the support of Councillor Brad Duguid, Police, Fire and Emergency Medical Services. The Conservatory Group and a family member of Conn Smythe concur with the naming proposal.

Notices to name the street, under the Municipal Act, 2001, will be given in accordance with the notice requirement set out in Chapter 162-3A of the City of Toronto Municipal Code.

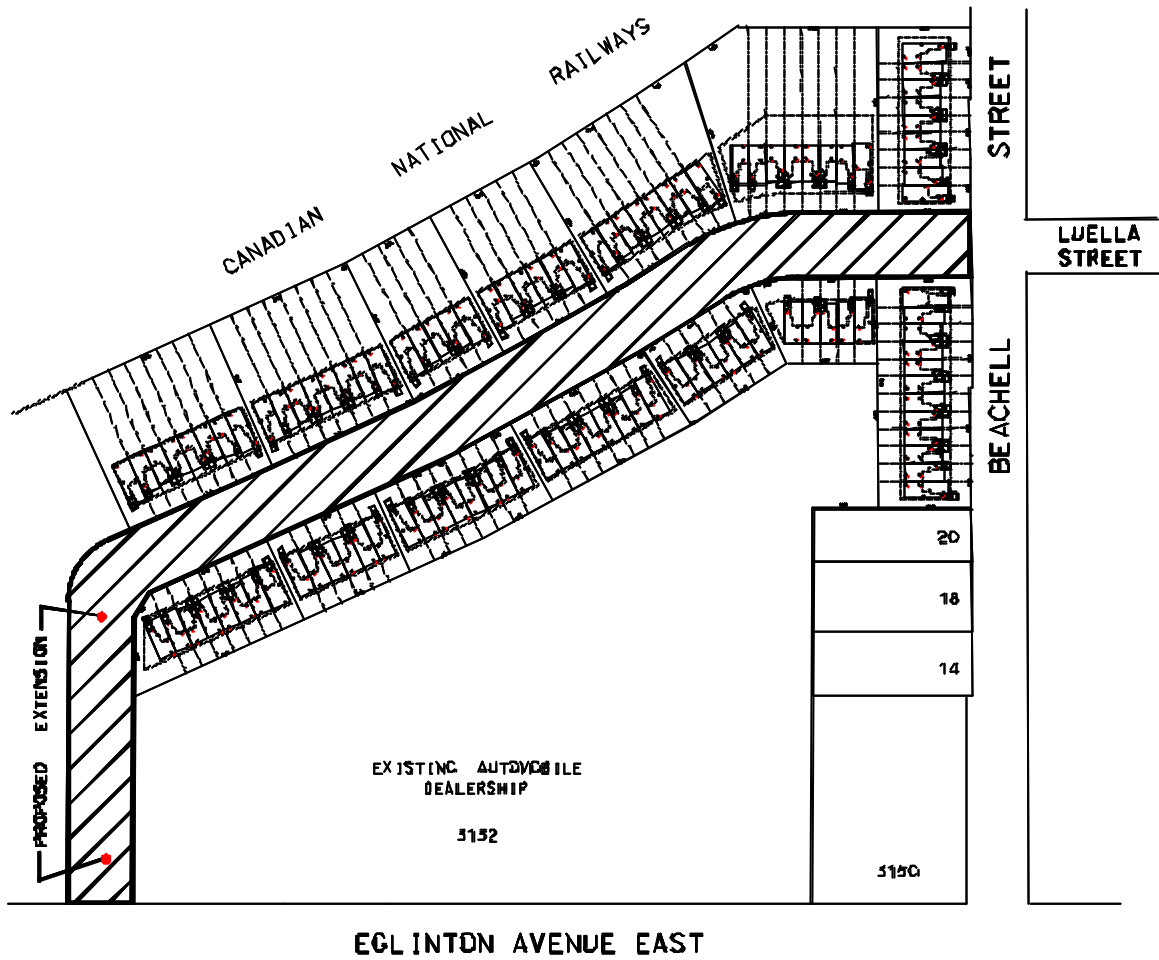
Conclusions:

The proposed name "Conn Smythe Drive" is consistent with the City of Toronto Street Naming Policy approved by City Council at its meeting held on August 1, 2, 3 and 4, 2000 (Clause 9, Report 15 of the Works Committee) and should therefore be approved for use in identifying the proposed public street.
